

Notice Regarding Extension of Licenses Pursuant to Executive Order 20-64

*****Effective 1/26/2021, the January 10th expiration date pursuant to EO-20-64 has been extended to **January 26, 2021*******

Executive Order No. 20-64 grants the Kansas Real Estate Commission the power to extend without penalty the April 30, 2020, June 30, 2020, August 31, 2020, October 31, 2020, December 31, 2020 and January 1, 2021 license expiration dates **to January 26, 2020**. Therefore, pursuant to that Order, all complete renewal applications for licenses that were to expire on April 30, 2020, June 30, 2020, August 31, 2020, October 31, 2020, December 31, 2020 and January 1, 2021 will be considered timely if received by the Commission on or before January 26, 2021. However, the Commission will consider the renewal application late if it is received after January 26, 2021, and a late fee will apply to applicants attempting renewal under those circumstances. K.S.A. 58-3045(c)
