

Notice Regarding Extension of Licenses Pursuant to Executive Order 21-02

*****Effective 1/26/2021, the January 26th expiration date pursuant to EO-20-64 has been extended to **March 31st, 2021*******

Executive Order No. 21-02 grants the Kansas Real Estate Commission the power to extend without penalty the April 30, 2020, June 30, 2020, August 31, 2020, October 31, 2020, December 31, 2020, January 1, 2021, February 1, 2021 and March 1, 2021 license expiration dates **to March 31st, 2021**.

Therefore, pursuant to that Order, all complete renewal applications for licenses that were to expire on April 30, 2020, June 30, 2020, August 31, 2020, October 31, 2020, December 31, 2020, January 1, 2021, February 1, 2021 and March 1, 2021 will be considered timely if received by the Commission on or before **March 31, 2021**. However, the Commission will consider the renewal application late if it is received after March 31, 2021, and a late fee will apply to applicants attempting renewal under those circumstances. K.S.A. 58-3045(c)
